LEGO-based therapy for children aged 5-7 years

Social skills are a typical area of difficulty for children on the autism spectrum. Developing these skills happens most successfully when using favourite activities and interests.

LEGO is commonly a strong interest making it an ideal tool to teach social skills, including communication, turn taking, waiting, following directions and asking for help.

Three children will participate this four-day intensive program. The **1.5 hour-long sessions** are led by a therapist experienced in supporting children on the spectrum and delivered using the 'LEGO-based Therapy' approach (LeGoff et al).
