



Early Childhood Intervention Group Programs

Intensive intervention for young children on the autism spectrum.

Autism Queensland's early childhood intervention group programs will support your young child with ASD to develop the skills necessary for successful participation in home and community life.

Our team of specialist therapists and educators will also help them prepare for successful transition into the next stage of their education.

Essential components of the group programs include:

- Recognising the **specific needs** of young children with autism
- Acknowledging that **parents** are crucial members of the team who will help your child achieve success.
- Using the child's **individual strengths** and interests to motivate learning and develop skills

- **Teaching skills** that are meaningful and useful for each child
- A positive approach to **behaviour support** which focuses on understanding the reasons for undesirable behaviour.

A maximum of **six children** will attend this program, **two days or three days per week** during school terms, for a minimum of 12 months.
