A ten-week group for children on the autism spectrum (aged 7-12) designed to help develop their social skills.

Social skills are a typical area of difficulty for children on the spectrum. Developing these skills happens most successfully when favourite activities and interests are used to encourage engagement, curiosity, communication, sharing and waiting for a turn.

LEGO® is commonly a strong interest for children on the autism spectrum and is ideal to use as a tool to teach and practice social skills.

LEGO® Club uses this medium of LEGO®, alongside the expertise of an experienced allied health professional, to facilitate and build on your child's social skills within a structured small group. Children will work collaboratively in groups of three, following assigned roles to complete LEGO® sets.

Children must be able to use language to communicate, as well as function in a group without requiring one-on-one support in order for this program to meet their needs.
