Studio G is an **interactive group that supports young people on the spectrum aged 18+ years** in their transition to employment, training or further education.

The group uses mentors with industry expertise to develop the participants' skills in the areas of game development, animation, short filmmaking, photography & graphic design, music and sound (for film and media) and creative writing.

The group is structured to allow participants to develop at their own pace and, with the assistance of their mentors, develop and complete projects in accordance with goals they themselves have set.

Sessions are facilitated in a nurturing and supportive environment where young people can build social skills, a sense of inclusion, and confidence in their own potential to achieve goals.
