**A revolutionary and evidence based social skills program for
children aged 8-12 years with social and emotional challenges**

SAS is a fun, espionage-themed group which helps children ages 8-12 develop the skills to feel happier, calmer, and braver, while also teaching them how to make and keep friends. SAS Club Cadets will learn these skills through engaging in a fun computer game alongside weekly group sessions with peers, and weekly take-home missions to develop their communication and emotional regulation skills.

Parents and Caregivers will be supported to make use of strategies in between group sessions through weekly parent group sessions, and resources will be included to support the transition of strategies to school and home.

The group involves a series of weekly child and parent group meetings with 2 follow-up sessions at approximately 3 and 6 months.

Licenses to access "Digital HQ" with the computer game, all electronic resources, and access to their mentor portal are available to purchase from Autism Queensland at a cost of \$185.00*. Further information will be provided at the time of the group.
