Primary Health Networks (PHNs) across Queensland are offering services that make getting a vaccine easier for people who cannot get to a vaccination clinic.

Getting the COVID-19 vaccine is important for everyone to protect people from getting very sick or even dying from COVID-19.

Getting vaccinated also helps protect people by slowing the spread of the virus.

Supporting vulnerable people who are housebound

Many vulnerable people may be housebound or have other obstacles or health conditions that prevent them from attending a vaccination hub, clinic or pharmacy.

Service providers who have not been able to arrange vaccination for this group of clients can contact their local PHN to discuss options, including in-home appointments, to ensure vulnerable people get access to the vaccine and are protected against COVID-19.
