

# AUTISM & HANDWRITING

Handwriting, copying from the board, and being neat are reported to be some of the most difficult activities for a student on the autism spectrum at school.

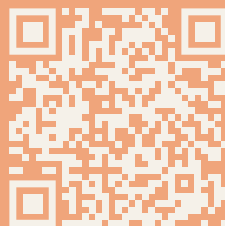
