Educators will learn how to:

- Create respectful and positive relationships.
- Uphold dignity and rights.
- Recognise the value of positive encouragement.
- Understand the importance of respecting family and cultural values, age, physical and intellectual development, and the abilities of each child.

This in turn supports children to:

- Experience positive relationships and interactions with others.
- Develop self-reliance and self-esteem.
- Share their opinions and express themselves.
